
Sir Derek H. R. Barton (1918–1998)

- Born in Gravesend, Kent (England).
- PhD in 1942 (Imperial College London).
- 1949–1950: at **Harvard University** (USA). Conformation of steroids.
- Then at Brikbeck College (UK) as a reader, then as a professor.
- 1955: professor at the **University of Glasgow**.
- 1957: professor at Imperial College London.
- 1969: Nobel prize in Chemistry for his work on conformational analysis.



- 1978–1986: head of the Institut de Chimie des Substances Naturelles (ICSN) in Gif-sur-Yvette (France).
- 1986: professor at the Texas A&M University in College Station (USA).
